

## Smocking Lace Pattern



THE LACE REQUIRED CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE WORLD OF LACE

**5 METRES FOR \$6.00 (enough for 3 hangers )**

You will need our 'SMK' lace for this project, and you will find that it is very economic coat hanger to make. You can make at least 4 basic (without skirt) hangers from an 8 metre bundle of the lace, or 3 like the one above (Pattern No 2). Any lace that has a row of holes along the top can be substituted for the skirt rows (first and last rows)

### **SMOCKED COATHANGER No 1**

(2 rows of lace)

Before you start, turn under one hole of the lace and count the number of holes that you require for the first row of lace. Mark with a pin. Count the holes on the other side of the lace. The number may be different. The excess holes can be used up by missing a hole in so many stitches on the longer side

#### **You need:**

- 8 Ply Wool
- No 9 (3.75) Needles
- 1.7 metres of World of Lace 'SMK' adult size

## **TO MAKE**

Cast on 66 sts

Knit 3 rows

4th row - Knit into the bottom hole of the lace

Knit 5 Rows

10th Row - Knit into the top hole of the lace

Knit 5 rows

16th row - Knit into the bottom hole of the lace

Knit 5 rows

22th row - Knit into the top hole of the lace

Knit 3 rows

Cast off
